ENHANCED FUND-RAISING ALLOCATION and SCHOLARSHIP FINANCIAL AID APPLICATION FOR ETC STUDENTS

Enhanced Fund-Raising Allocation and/or Scholarships are available to any ETC student at varying degrees dependant upon need, qualification, and commitment. Students and/or their families may apply for financial aid through the following mechanisms.

1. **Enhanced Fund-Raising Allocation:** Money earned through fund-raising participation is normally allocated into a student's personal account on a proportionate basis depending on the particular fund-raising activity. However, students may apply for an enhanced (i.e. higher percentage) allocation of funds into their personal account. If granted, the student will receive an award letter indicating the enhanced percentage amount given.
2. **Scholarships:** ETC has a limited amount of funds available to assist qualified students in financial need. Students may apply for scholarship funds. The ETC Scholarship Committee will award either full or partial scholarships to qualified applicants. If awarded a full or partial scholarship, the student will receive an award letter indicating the amount directly deposited into their personal account. (Scholarships apply to tuition only.)
 - a. **Linda Saffles Memorial Scholarships** – This scholarship is awarded to two students of ETC in the amount of \$250 each. Linda Saffles was a woman who truly valued ETC for its friendships, for the giving of song, dance, and goodwill to the community, and for the nurturing of its members. Linda was very active with the group while her daughter Nikki was a member. She was instrumental in the construction of the rehearsal hall at Canal Place, chaperoned many trips, helped manage the ETC office, and enjoyed participating in many other facets of the organization. Linda truly loved being around the kids and they knew she cared for them. Linda lost her battle with cancer in early 2001. She left us with a memory of a wonderful lady who truly cared for others and whose smiling face welcomed and encouraged so many. Linda invested herself in ETC during her life and there is no doubt that she would want to continue her support.
 - b. **ETC Foundation and Grant Scholarships** – awarded in varied amounts through the ETC Foundation and other generous grants as available.
